program should note:

1. The Cut-off date for allotment of Government merit quota seats and closure of admissions entitling Management to collect liquidated damages will be announced by the Government in due course, which shall be binding on all applicants seeking admission for BPT program during the academic year 2026-27.

Revision of fee and other charges, if any, approved by the Admission & Fee Regulatory Committee or State Government/competent Court shall be levied from students seeking admission/admitted during the academic year 2026-27.

The College is situated at Devagiri P.O, Kangazha, Kottayam- 686555 and is blessed with natural beauty and resources. The College functions in a separate building 0.6 kms to the Parent Hospital MGDM Hospital with 250 inpatient beds. The College offers a 5 year course of study leading to BPT degree which is awarded by Kerala University of Health Sciences, Thrissur after successful completion of another one year compulsory internship.

II Institutions and Number of Seats

No. of seats: The annual intake: BPT-50

- (a) **All the candidates admitted shall pay the fees fixed by Government of Kerala/Fee Regulatory Committee and as approved or modified by competent authorities.**

(b) Admission to course in the institution for which approval/permission has not been obtained will be subject to the approval/permission from the Kerala University of Health Sciences/Government of Kerala

III Eligibility for Admission

Academic:

BPT PROGRAMME

Subject to the approval of the Government /KUHS. Should have passed Higher Secondary examination conducted by Board of Higher Secondary Education, Kerala or examination equivalent there to as approved by Kerala University of Health Sciences, Thrissur. Should have separate minimum pass mark for Physics Chemistry and Biology and 50% marks in Physics, Chemistry, and Biology put together.

Note:-

- (i) In Kerala Higher Secondary courses or examinations recognized equivalent there to with two year course where the Board Examinations are conducted in both years, the total marks of two years in the respective subjects as shown in the mark lists of the respective Higher Secondary Boards will be considered for academic eligibility.
- (ii) In Higher Secondary courses or examinations recognized equivalent thereto where Board Examinations are conducted only at the end of 12th class (final year), the marks in the respective subjects as shown in the mark lists of the respective Higher Secondary Boards will be considered for academic eligibility.
- (iii) For all other type of Higher Secondary courses or examinations recognized equivalent there to the marks of the respective subjects as shown in the mark list of the respective Board of Examinations will be considered for academic eligibility.
- (iv) The Vocational Higher Secondary Examination, Kerala, has been recognized as equivalent to the Higher Secondary Examination, Kerala.

Admission quota & General conditions.

- Selection of students shall be made on the basis of norms prescribed by Govt. of Kerala / Kerala University of Health Sciences from time to time.
- 50% of the total seats of the College will be offered to the Government to be filled from the list prepared by the LBS Centre for Science & Technology, as merit seats in accordance with merit and reservation principles followed by Government from time to time.
- 35% of the total seats shall be filled up from among the candidates who are eligible as per the Prospectus for the course and also based on the applications received against notification by College Management directly and in accordance with merit in the qualifying examination.
- 15% of total seats of the Colleges shall be filled up by eligible students who are children/dependents of Non-resident Indians.
- Levying amount towards liquidated damages from candidates discontinuing their studies shall be as in the related clause of prospectus 2026-27 issued by the Director of Medical Education, Trivandrum and as per the final decision of the ASC/Court of Law.
- The cut-off date for allotment of seats under Government merit quota for the year 2026- 2027 shall be as per the understanding with the State Government.

BPT-NRI Seats

The Management is entitled to fill up to 15% of the total seats as NRI category by admitting qualified students who are dependents of NRIs. According to GO (MS)No.243/2014/H&FWD dated 06.08.2014 & Admission Supervisory Committee Orders.

- a. A candidate, who apply for the NRI seat should submit the Passport copy and Visa/Green Card/OCI Documents of their respective sponsors. The Job of the sponsor should be mentioned in any of the above documents.
- b. The Visa of the sponsor should be valid till the closing date of admission in respect of the Medical and Allied Courses.
- c. In case, the employment of the sponsor is not mentioned in the above documents, the candidate has to produce the employment certificate of the sponsor attested by the Embassy / Consulate authorities.
- d. The certificates clearly establishing the relationship of the sponsor with the candidate shall be obtained from the revenue authorities, as per the G.O (Ms)No. 243/14/H&FWD dated 06.08.2014.

However, the relationship between the candidate and his/her father/mother, recorded in the educational certificates, shall be accepted.

RRs maintained in the usual course of transactions by the competent authorities, shall be accepted.

e. The Candidate shall produce the sworn-in affidavit from the Sponsor in a stamp paper worth Rs. 200/-. The same shall also be notarized by the Notary Public, disclosing that the student is dependent of the sponsor and all expenses i.e. tuition fee and special fee, of the candidate for the entire course period will be borne by the Sponsor.

f. All the certificates/documents required to establish NRI Status/Non-Creamy Layer/Minority etc. shall be produced at the time of submission of application itself. The certificate produced later shall not be entertained under any circumstances.

“An Applicant who depends upon his/her Father / Mother / Brothers and Sisters (inclusive of first cousins) / Husband / Wife / Brothers and Sisters (inclusive of first cousins) of Father or Mother /Half Brother/Half Sister/Adopted Father or Adopted Mother who is working abroad” will only be eligible to apply in the NRI category seats.

(ii) **Relaxation in marks:-**

Candidates belonging to Socially and Educationally Backward Classes (as per G.O. (P) No. 208/66/Edn. dated 2.5.1966, G.O.(MS) No.95/08/SCSTDD dated 06.10.2008 and amendments thereof), will have a relaxation of 5% marks in the qualifying examination. They need only 45% marks in the case of Biology where it is required separately and 45% marks in the case of optional subjects put together. The Scheduled Castes and Scheduled Tribes candidates need only a pass in the qualifying examination.

The relaxation of marks in the qualifying examination extended to SEBC candidates only will be applicable to OEC candidates even if they are allotted against the un-availed seats of SC/ST quota. Also refer Clause 5.4.2(e). In respect of candidates, included in the PwD quota list published by the LBS Centre, the minimum marks required for admission shall be 5% less than that prescribed for general category.

No rounding off of the percentage of marks to the nearest whole number is permitted. For example, a score of 50 marks out of 100 or 150 marks out of 300 alone will be considered as 50% marks and scores of 45 out of 100 or 135 out of 300 alone will be considered as 45% marks for determining eligibility.

Candidates who have appeared for the Higher Secondary or equivalent examination will be permitted to submit the application. However, they should attain the prescribed qualification before the last date prescribed for submission of application.

Candidates should have attained the academic eligibility (Clause- 6.2 in LBS Prospectus 2026-27) on or before the last date specified in the Notification for submission of application.

- (a) Candidates belonging to SEBC (Socially and Educationally Backward Classes) in the State of Kerala with total annual family income up to Rs.6 lakhs will have relaxation of 5% marks. The Scheduled Caste and Scheduled Tribe candidates in the State of Kerala need only a pass in the qualifying examination.

- (b) Those candidates claiming relaxation of marks shall produce necessary certificates from the authority concerned. There will be no reservation of seats for SEBC and or SC/ST candidates under Management quota.
- (iii) **Eligibility Certificates:** Candidates who have passed their qualifying examination from places other than State of Kerala shall produce the Certificate of eligibility from KUHS and the migration certificate from the Board / University last enrolled in. This should be furnished at the time of interview for admission.

. **Age:**

- (i) Applicants should have completed 17years of age on the 31st December 2026.No relaxation of the minimum age will be allowed.
- (ii) Self attested copy of relevant page of school record namely SSLC/ICSE/CBSE/ certificate showing the date of birth / copy of birth certificate should be produced at the time of admission.

. **How to Apply.**

- . - All applications shall be submitted ONLINE on the website of the college www.smptcollege.com in the following manner:

Before applying online, candidates should have:

A valid email ID (If you do not have an email address, create a Gmail ID).

Scanned copy of recent (taken after 1st January 2026) passport size colour photograph. Photograph should be taken in a white/light coloured background. The image should be in JPEG format.

Maximum size for photograph 50KB and image dimension is 120x150px (4.23x5.29cm).

- . Application for admission to Bachelor of Physiotherapy course scan be registered only online through a single application. The provision for applying online is available at the website www.smptcollege.com. Submission of more than one application by a candidate will lead to rejection of the applications for the same course submitted subsequent to the first application.

The candidate can complete the application process with the following steps.

STEP1: Pay the Application Fees mentioned above with the bank details.

STEP 2: Take a screenshot of your payment receipt or have the payment receipt in PDF file format.

STEP3: Visit the following Button//Apply Online Now

- a. Register into St Mary's College of Physiotherapy website www.smptcollege.com using a valid Email-ID (preferably Gmail ID) after selecting the applicable Physiotherapy course (BPT). Access the portal using the password provided to you in your e-mail or SMS to you in your mobile number registered with College of Physiotherapy to complete the online application form, and SUBMIT the application online.
- b. After FINAL SUBMISSION, take a print out of the completed application form and submit along with the required documents and application fee relevant to each course (Original Demand Draft) to: The Principal, St Mary's College of Physiotherapy, MGDM Hospital, Devagiri P.O, Kangazha, Kottayam, Kerala District, Pincode-686555 through Registered Post/Speed Post/ Courier.
- c. The online application shall be confirmed only on the receipt of the print out and verification of the documents. In case of any discrepancies between the online data and the details on the copies of the relevant documents, the latter alone shall be accepted. The application fee once remitted will not be refunded at any stage.

- d. The last date for receipt of duly signed print out of online application at the St Mary's College of Physiotherapy office is October 25th , 2026 at 05:00 p.m.

4.5 Availability of Prospectus can also be downloaded from www.smptcollege.com. However, it will not be available by post or from any of the office.

4.6 Submit the Print out of the Online Application (Hard Copy) and Applicants for NRI admission should submit the following documents along with the application form;

- a. Sponsorship Certificate in the stamp paper & Declaration of the Sponsor.
- b. Employment Certificate of the Sponsor.
- c. Valid Passport copy of the Sponsor with Embassy Certificate/ Consulate/Green Card documents/OCI Documents of their respective sponsors. . In case of non-submission of embassy certificate, the endorsement in the passport of the sponsor about the employment shall be accepted or employment contract.
- d. Visa Copy of the Sponsor with Embassy Attestation. The attested copy of the relevant page of the passport where Employment Visa is stamped and if it is not submitted the employment certificate duly attested by the Indian Embassy or consulate.

Relationship Certificate from the Village Officer/ Tahasildar Relationship with the sponsor should comply the Government order No.GO(MS) No.193/2013/H&FWD dtd.22.05.2013& KUHS Order No.2836/ACB/kuhs/2014,dated 12.06.2014.

- e. The self-attested copies of certificates/ documents as per the check list in the hard copy of application shall be submitted along with the each application.
- f. The hard copy applications (printout of online applications) submitted should be complete in all respects. Applications not accompanied by documents in proof of claims made therein are liable to be summarily rejected without further intimation. Copies of documents/certificates furnished after submission of the application will not be entertained under any circumstances. No opportunity will be given to incorporate any details or document after the submission of the application. Late and incomplete applications will be rejected.

V. Allotment of Different Categories and Preparing of Rank list

5.1 Allotment Categories

(a) 35% of seats will be filled by management from among the applications received online and on the basis of merit list prepared based on the marks obtained in the qualifying examination in the core subjects as mentioned in the eligibility criteria.

(b) 15% of seats will be filled from among the applications received from NRI students fulfilling the eligibility criteria on the basis of merit list prepared based on the marks obtained in the qualifying examination in the core subjects as mentioned in the eligibility criteria as also fulfilling the eligibility norms of NRI quota notified by the State Govt.

5.2 Preparation of Rank list

(a) Rank List : For allotment to BPT : Rank List will be prepared on the basis of marks obtained by candidates for Physics, Chemistry, Biology put together at the final year of the qualifying examination.

(b) Procedure for normalization: The marks scored by the candidates in each subject in the Qualifying Examination conducted by various Boards will be made comparable with the marks obtained by the students in the same subjects in the qualifying examination conducted by the Directorate of Higher Secondary Examination, Kerala.

Let 'X' be the maximum mark secured out of 100 for a subject in the state Higher Secondary Board and 'Y' the maximum mark secured out of 100 for the same subject in any other stream AISCSE/ISC/VHSE.

If 'T' is the mark secured out of 100 for the subject by a student of the other board (CBSE/ICSE/VHSE) in the year, then his/her normalized mark of the subject, say 'Z' equals $(T \times X)/Y$ (the value to be corrected to four decimal places.)

Illustration

Subject: Chemistry Year: 2026

Max. Mark out of 100 secured in the State Board

100 Max. Mark out of 100 secured in the ISC = 99

The normalized mark of an ISC student who secured 85 out of 100 in Chemistry will be equal to $(85 \times 100)/99 = 85.8586$.

In the case of students whose qualifying examination is Higher Secondary Examination conducted by the Directorate of Higher Secondary Education, Kerala, the actual marks obtained will be considered for ranking.

VI. Selection of Allotment Process

6.1 The open merit and NRI rank lists of all applicants will be prepared and published on the website, www.smptcollege.com on the basis of the total percentage of marks obtained in the core subjects of the qualifying examination. The open merit rank list for BPT will be prepared on the basis of the percentage of marks obtained in Physics, Chemistry and Biology or equivalent subjects in the qualifying

examination.

The marks obtained for the qualifying exam will be subject to normalization process as explained below.

This process will be done taking into consideration the marks of those candidates who apply pursuant to this prospectus only.

The marks obtained by the students in the relevant subjects in the qualifying examination conducted by various boards or authority shall be equated with the marks obtained by the students in the same subjects in the qualifying Examination conducted by the Director of HSE, Kerala, by adopting the method of normalization

VII. Admission & Payment of fee

7.1 The selected candidates will be informed through SMS in the registered mobile number with the College

7.2 The students shall pay all fees of the 1st year of the course at the time of admission . Candidates who express their intention not to pursue studies in the paramedical college before the last date fixed for closure of admission will be eligible for refund of the 1st year tuition fee and other fees except admission fee. They will be eligible to get back their original certificates handed over to the college at the time of admission.

7.3 Approved Tuition Fee and special fee shall be collected through online Payment/Cheque/DD/RTGS/IMPS etc .from the candidates.

8.1 Spot allotment and admission in the open merit rank order of applicants will be held to fill up the remaining vacant seats after three online allotments, if required.

The centralized spot allotment and admission will be at College Conference Hall.

The venue and schedule of counselling will be notified on the website of the St Mary's College of Physiotherapy, later.

All original documents and certificates should be submitted at the college desk at the time of spot admission.

8.2 The students shall pay all fees of the 1st year of the course at the time of admission which will not be refunded under any circumstances.

8.3 Fees shall be collected only the approved tuition fee and special fee through online payment/Cheque/DD/RTGS/IMPS etc. from the candidates.
